WHAT TO BRING:

- Emergency release form
- Change of clothes
- Snack (labeled with name)
- Picture I.D. at sign out

SIGN-IN/SIGN-OUT:

Please be sure to sign-in your child each day. Sign-in and sign-out are located at our cityside entrance off Museum Drive on the north side of the building. Staff will admit your child and answer any questions you may have. You can sign your child in as early as 8:00 a.m.

Picture ID is Required at Sign-out:

Sign-out is between 12:00 and 12:30 p.m. Please be prompt. For the safety of your child, we use your emergency form to organize a list of adults to whom your child can be released.

EMERGENCY FORM:

Please thoroughly complete and turn in an emergency form (attached) by the first day of camp. Your children cannot participate in L.A.B.S. if we don't have a completed emergency form on file. This form determines to whom we can release your child and notes important contacts, allergies, and information to ensure your child's safety.

Please mail the emergency form to our Reservations Coordinator prior to the first date of camp. You may also bring the completed form with you on the first day your child is schedule to attend L.A.B.S.

L.A.B.S. staffs are trained to handle minor injuries, but will contact emergency personnel in serious health situations.

EMERGENCY CONTACT FOR L.A.B.S.:

If you have a personal emergency during L.A.B.S. camps, you can call our dedicated emergency line: (517) 515-3782. **Do not call this line to reserve, cancel, or change a camp. It is only for immediate contact with the L.A.B.S coordinator.**

TENTATIVE DAILY SCHEDULE:

8:00 – 9:00 a.m.	Free Exploration (during drop-off)
9:00 – 12:00 p.m.	Camp Programming
12:00 – 12:30 p.m.	After-care (optional)

PARTICIPANTS:

Camp space is limited to ensure an excellent staff-to-child ratio. Our class limit for the 3-5 age group is 12 children.

EXPLORATION & CAMP ACTIVITIES:

Free Exploration: Between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m., children can choose their own exploration path in the supervised main exhibit area. The Science Center is closed to the public until 10:00 a.m.

Between 9:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m., camp programming includes free exploration time in the exhibit area, as well as time in classrooms and outside. If children are in areas with public visitors, we create smaller zoned sections for safe supervision.

Camp Programming:

Trained staff lead your children in hands-on science lessons. All activities are designed to encourage the scientific process, questions, exploration, thought, conversation, and reflection.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Personal Items:

Impression 5 does not recommend bringing Nintendo DS, cell phones, or other electronic devices. Children who do bring these items are allowed to use them only during free exploration times. **Impression 5 is not responsible for any lost or broken items.**

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS:

Please contact us as soon as possible if you need to cancel your reservation for L.A.B.S. camps as we have an active waiting list.

Advanced Cancellation (more than one week until program):

There is a \$25.00 cancellation fee for a full week camp and a \$5.00 fee for a single day camp. Or, you may opt for a 100% refund on an Impression 5 Gift Card.

Last-minute Cancellation (less than one week before program):

You will receive a 100% refund of the program fee on an Impression 5 gift card or opt for a refund of 75% of the program cost.

No refunds are available after the Friday before a L.A.B.S. camp.

WHAT TO WEAR:

L.A.B.S. camps can be messy, and experiments may be held inside or outdoors. Appropriate clothing is required.

- No flip-flops or "wheeled shoes."
- Bring a complete change of clothes in case of messy projects or accidents.
- Bring any special outdoor sunscreen, bug repellent, or bee sting kits.

Impression 5 provides children with sunscreen before we go outdoors. Children apply their own sunscreen.
