2. Delivers science curriculum in camp settings to children ages 3 to 14 that is hands-on, dynamic, and learner driven.
3. Acts as an individual directly responsible for the care of children attending camp.
4. Supports all operations of L.A.B.S. camp program including before/after care, lunch, and outdoor play.
5. Delivers science workshops to guests in varied group dynamics.
6. Facilitates science experiences in community outreaches.
7. Creates positive opportunities for guests that are science-focused and social.
8. Maintains a high level of customer service while assisting guests in the Exploration Area and while delivering programs.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Certified in CPR/First Aid preferred.
